2020 DRY GRAD DINNER

Restaurants are among the businesses allowed to reopen, under enhanced protocols, during Phase 2 of BC's Restart Plan.

The 2020 Dry Grad planning committee has identified an opportunity to rent a 1920's themed restaurant and host multiple small scale (40-50 student) Dry Grad Dinners in July.

- Students wishing to attend an evening dinner theatre style celebration are welcome to dress in casual or formal attire.
- Sign up will be in the form of table reservations with attendees choosing their party size and composition. No more than six students will be seated at a table.
- Venue capacity will be managed in compliance with Public Health and Worksafe BC Restaurant Guidelines.

SURVEY

Large scale events will not be possible until Phase 4 (TREATMENT or VACCINE) of BC's Restart Plan. Recognizing this may be several months if not years from now, our committee explored alternative ways to honour this year's Grade 12 students.

- We asked for feedback through a survey sent in May.
- 256 families responded to the survey with 82% of participants (218) expressing interest and comfort around sending the Grade 12 student in their household to a small-scale dinner event.

2020 DRY GRAD PLANNING COMMITTEE

The NWSS Dry Grad planning committee is made up of parent volunteers who spend countless hours raising funds and organizing a large-scale alcohol and drug free celebration for students of the graduating class.

Due to circumstances beyond our control, the all-night Dry Grad event scheduled to take place on June 25, 2020 has been cancelled. Retro themed small-scale Dry Grad Dinners are being planned in July as an alternative.

- Dry Grad activities are volunteer driven and not organized or funded by the school.
- Dry Grad is separate from the Dinner/Dance Formal and Grad Leaving Ceremony which are both school sponsored events.
