

NWSS DRY GRAD 2020 – Acknowledgement and Release

The Participant and Participant’s Guardian (if applicable) hereby represent that they understand and acknowledge the risks, dangers, and hazards which are inherent in accessing, visiting, and using the properties, facilities, and equipment to be used in connection with the graduation event (the “**Dry Grad Event**”) for graduates of New Westminster Secondary School to be held in July 2020 at The Metro Hall at 759 Carnarvon St, New Westminster, British Columbia (the “**Premises**”), which risks, include but are not limited to the risk of bodily injury, disability, illness (including contraction of COVID-19), death, or property damage arising from: interaction or contact with individuals who may have or have been exposed to COVID-19 or other pathogens; proximity to or contact with surfaces, fixtures, or other objects that may harbor COVID-19 or other pathogens; tripping hazards; equipment failures; negligent maintenance or use of the Premises; conduct of volunteers, chaperones, employees, or other attendees; participation in games and activities; or transportation to and from the Premises (collectively, the “**Risks**”). The Participant and the Participant’s Guardian (if applicable) represent that they are not relying on any oral or written representation or statement by any person in connection with their decision to participate in the Dry Grad Event. The Participant’s Guardian (if applicable) acknowledges that he or she is solely responsible for the safe transport of the Participant to and from the Premises.

In consideration of being permitted to participate in the Dry Grad Event and to access and use the Premises, the Participant and Participant’s Guardian (if applicable) hereby: (a) releases, discharges and forever holds harmless The Metro Events Inc., Chloe Good, the “NWSS dry grad committee”, and all of their respective members, partners, sponsors, agents, affiliates, directors, officers, employees, and volunteers (collectively, the “**Releasees**”) from any and all liability for damages or losses arising as a result of the Risks or arising from breach of contract, breach of statutory duties of care (including any duties of care owned under the *Occupiers Liability Act* of British Columbia), or negligence on the part of the Releasees, and (b) freely assumes the Risks and anything incidental to the Risks which may arise as a result of or in connection with participation in the Dry Grad Event or access to and use of the Premises.
