


How to sign into Microsoft Office 365


Note: You will need your student ID. If don't know this it can be found on the MyEdBC Family Portal located at https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen

Login to MyEdBC>Family Top Tab>Details Side Tab per below



Microsoft Office 365 Sign:

- 1. Open a web browser and go to http://portal.office.com
- 2. Sign in with your student ID. As an example, <u>87654@newwestschools.ca</u>
- 3. Click Next to continue



- 1. Enter in the password provided to you by the teacher
- 2. Click Sign In to continue






How to sign into Microsoft Office 365

For security & privacy reasons students should change their passwords as soon as possible using the following guidelines

- At least 8 characters made up of uppercase, lowercase, numbers and special characters. Teachers and Parents of younger students should assist as needed.
- Do not use your first name or last name in the password

To change your password

Click on the Gear icon at the top right of your screen and then click "change password"

- 1. **Teams** Online meetings
- 2. **Outlook** Email
- 3. *OneDrive* Document storage
- 4. Word, Excel, PowerPoint Word processing, spreadsheets and slide decks.
- 5. **OneNote** Taking notes
