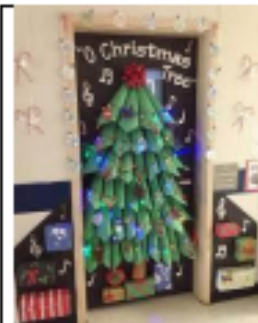

SOGI Tip of the Week:

If you misgender a person by mistake, it is best to apologize, correct yourself, and move on. [Ex. "I was telling her the other day... sorry, I mean I was telling them the other day ..."]

- Do not spend an excessive amount of time or draw excess attention to the mistake. This can make the person feel even more uncomfortable.
- Do not attempt to make excuses by saying "it's just so hard to remember." This can make a person feel as if their authentic existence is an inconvenience. No one deserves to feel that way. If you feel the need to affirm your effort, you can say "I will practice and do better."
- If you find yourself making mistakes, or worry that you might, practice talking about that person to yourself (or in your head) using the correct language, while visualizing the person. Like any habit, the more you practice, the fewer mistakes you will make.
