## **2021-2022 Independent Scholarships**

The following scholarships are available to Grade 12 graduating students in British Columbia. Please apply directly to the various organizations for each scholarship (except where otherwise noted\*).

### **THE HERBALAND COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP 2022 \$1,000**

The **Herbaland Community Scholarship** is awarded to **five outstanding students** in BC (Canada) school districts who demonstrate excellent performance in academics, leadership, and community involvement.

**Application Deadline:** **May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

**Criteria:** Must be a student graduating from high school in the 2022 year

- Minimum requirement of an 86% cumulative average (grade 11-12)
- Demonstrate involvement in the community through volunteering, through school and/or extracurricular activities
- Environment Focused: prioritizes sustainability through involvement in green initiatives and efforts
- Promotes diversity and inclusion in their community or at school
- Has taken a leadership role in either community, sustainability, or inclusivity.
- Must provide a reference letter from an organization that you've been involved in
- Written personal statement of 300-500 words detailing how Herbaland's core values of **sustainability**, **community**, and **inclusivity** apply to you.

## **CONFRATELLANZA ITALO-CANADESE 2022 SCHOLARSHIP**

**\$1,000**

The Confratellanza Italo-Canadese was founded in 1904 and is committed to the preservation of Italian cultural heritage and contributing to the enrichment of the multicultural community in the Greater Vancouver area. This year we are offering several \$1,000 scholarships to assist eligible students in their post-secondary studies:

**Application Deadline:** **June 15, 2022**

**Criteria:** A scholarship is also open to members of the Confratellanza Italo-Canadese and secondary school students or recent secondary school graduates having a parent or legal guardian that is a member in good standing of the Confratellanza Italo-Canadese or its affiliate the Lega Femminile Italiana. Candidates must have an academic standing, however, sufficient to qualify for the post-secondary institution of their choice.

- 1) be of Italian origin i.e. as having at least one parent or grandparent of direct Italian descent,
- 2) be living in a city or municipality within the 21-member Greater Vancouver Regional District,

3) have an academic standing sufficient to qualify for entry into the post-secondary institution of their choice, and

4) submit a completed application form with supporting documentation post-marked or delivered no later than **June 15, 2022**.

## **THE ELMER HELM YOUTH FUND**

**UP TO \$1,500**

The Elmer Helm Youth Fund provides financial assistance to deserving students who wish to pursue post-secondary training in the artistic, academic, or technical fields. It is the aim of the fund to make such education possible for students who may otherwise not have the financial means.

**Application Deadline:** **June 30, 2022**

**Criteria:** The fund is open to young people who are residents of BC, under the age of 25 who have been accepted into post-secondary training in an artistic, academic or technical field, and must be significantly involved in their community in a volunteer capacity.

The fund is open to young people under the age of 25 years old. This fund is not a primarily academic competition. Of equal importance to academic success is contribution to the community exemplifying the Neighbourhood House ideal of community service and strengthening communities. Recipients of the fund will receive \$1500 in two installments (August and January) over the course of the year.

Applicant must be 24 years of age or less at the time of application

**Criteria:** For youth who are currently in care or a former youth in care of the BC Ministry of Children & Family Development (MCFD) or Delegated Aboriginal Agency – either under a Continuing Custody Order (CCO) or Temporary Custody Order (TCO), Voluntary Care Agreement (VCA) or Special Care Agreement or Youth Agreement in BC.

## **AFABC YOUTH BURSARY**

**\$3,000**

The AFABC Youth Bursary awards financial assistance to youth who have joined their families by legal adoption, and plan to pursue a vocational, trade or academic post-secondary program at an accredited BC institution.

**Application Deadline:** **April 17, 2022**

### **Criteria:**

- You have joined your family by legal adoption or other forms of permanency (including, but not limited to, guardianship, Indigenous customary adoption, or moral adoption).
- You are currently a BC resident.
- You are 17 or over, and 26 or younger by the application deadline date. • You are registered, or plan to be registered, in a vocational, trade, or academic post secondary program at an accredited BC institution.
