CAST

- 1. A solo song from the musical theatre tradition sung to a backing track (youtube karaoke is fine). If possible, have a device with you that can play the backing track and have it ready when you enter the audition room. If you don't have a device, we will provide one for you.
- **2.** An age-appropriate **monologue** that is 1 to 2 minutes in length. Please bring a written copy of the monologue for the audition panel. Monologue must be fully memorized.
- 3. Choreography. A dance video will be posted to the website for you to learn on your own in advance of your audition date. Choreography will be performed in small groups at the start of your chosen audition time. You must be present and punctual for your audition time in order to perform the dance audition.
- 4. You must bring a **completed copy of the audition form**. The form is available on the school website at www.nwss.ca

Please print the form and fill it out IN ADVANCE of your audition.

5. A current headshot (photograph) that can be left with the audition panel. This does NOT need to be a professional headshot. For example, a Facebook profile picture printed out is fine. This photo will be kept by the audition panel, so don't bring a photo you want returned to you.
